Specifically the By Law changes are for Article VI - Rules, Sections 4 and 5. They will now read...

Section 4 — A score must be posted each time a player completes a round of golf. A member must post her score, rating and slope of any round of golf played at a course other than Woodside Plantation. After completing at least 13 holes of golf, a score should be posted according to the USGA rules. If the player completes 7 -12 holes, than she must post a 9-hole round.

Section 5 — Members will specify whether they are joining Division A - competing from the Azalea tees or Division B - competing from the Burden tees. Members can switch their tee selection one time per year. Fifty-four (54) holes from the appropriate tees or an index from GHIN based on rounds at a past Club will be used to establish a handicap for 18 holes allowing the player to compete for awards.
