\*Participants will be charged \$1.00 to their club account after a WPLGA member has a hole-in-one.

#### **CHOOSING YOUR TEE**

Members will specify whether they are joining Division A - competing from the Azalea tees or Division B - competing from the Burden tees. Members may switch their tee selection one time per year. Fifty-four (54) holes or an index from rounds at a past club will be used to establish a handicap for 18 holes allowing the player to compete for prizes.

All LGA tournaments/shotguns will be played from the players declared tees.

In order to be eligible for team play, a person's index must be predominately established from the Woodside Tees.

## THURSDAY AND SATURDAY PLAY

Woodside Ladies Golf Association play day shall be Thursday or Saturday of each week. Thursday is the regular play day. Specific procedures are detailed in the LGA Play Day Procedures.

We ask all members to do their part to help the LGA keep their preferred Thursday tee times and to keep the option open for <u>occasional</u> Saturday play. This will help ensure that our preferred tee times for Thursday remain intact.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR THURSDAY / SATURDAY PLAYDAYS**

#### BEFORE PLAY:

- Check in at Pro Shop at least 20 minutes ahead of tee time
- On LGA sign-in sheet, initial beside name & circle the appropriate Burden or Azalea handicap
- Check the correct course & game to play from the sign-in sheet
- Be at starting hole at least 10 minutes prior to your tee time

• If you sign in for the game but do not start the round, remove your name from the sign-in sheet

#### **DURING PLAY:**

- For each person, mark scorecard as follows:
  - 1st line first initial and last name, hole-by-hole scores, gross score and handicap
  - 2nd line posting #, game score for holes that count, total game/net score
    Write no more than one score per block
- Keep two scorecards for all players to compare scores at the end
  - If you pick up on a hole that does not count for the game:
  - Record an approximate score for hole but no more than your max
  - Mark score with an "X" (example: 7x)
  - That hole does not count for Ringers or Birdies/Chip-Ins
- If you have reached your max on a hole that does not count:
  - Pick up ball, record max score with an "X" (example: 9x), continue to next hole
  - If you pick up on hole that does count for the game:
  - You must withdraw from the game
  - Write a big WD beside your name
  - Turn in your card after play and post score (if you finished 7 or more holes)
- If you voluntarily withdraw from the game:
  - Write a big WD beside your name

• Turn in your card after play and post score (if you finished 7 or more holes)

• Keep pace with group ahead of you or at the pace dictated by the pace of play card in the golf cart sign-in sheet

#### AFTER PLAY:

- Write gross score and game score on the card for all players
- Compare both cards and correct any errors. Each player is responsible for her own score and information
- Sign, date, and attest one of the cards (the most legible one) the signatures for scorer and attest must be two independent LGA members
- Put attested card into the Play Day box in the ladies' locker room immediately after play
- Post your adjusted gross score (or AGS) the **DAY YOU PLAY**. All scores must be posted when 7+ holes are played, even if you withdraw.

#### **DISQUALIFICATIONS & WITHDRAWALS:**

A player who WITHDRAWS (WD) or is DISQUALIFIED (DQ) is not eligible for game points, Ringers or Birdies/Chip-Ins.

- Reasons for Disqualification include:
  - Scorecard is not dated or is not signed and attested by two separate LGA players
  - Scorecard not submitted to Tournament Committee immediately after the round
  - Played the game on wrong course
  - Skipped or picked up on a hole that counted for the game
  - Did not complete at least 14 holes
- Did not play and complete the game on LGA play day with another

#### LGA member COUNTING BIRDIES/CHIP-INS AND RINGERS, AND POSTING OF SCORES:

- Birdies and chip-ins can count when all of these conditions are met:
  - The player is playing her own ball throughout the round
  - The birdie/eagle is holed out, not conceded or given

- The B/C form is completed, signed, attested and turned in after the round
- Mulligan is not used on the B/C hole
- Ringers can be counted when all of these conditions are met:
  - The player is playing her own ball throughout the round
  - The hole is holed out, not given or conceded
  - No Mulligans are used during the round
- Scores from an LGA tournament should be posted if all of these conditions are met:
  - The player plays her own ball throughout the round, even when putts are given or conceded. If a player picks up on a hole, she can post the score she thinks she would have made on that hole. If the hole is not played, she can post the par plus handicap score for that hole.
  - The player completes at least 7 holes.

#### CRITERIA FOR DISQUALIFICATIONS (DQ) AND WITHDRAWLS (WD)

• See current LGA handbook.





#### **BIRDIES/CHIP-INS & HOLE-IN-ONE**

- If you have a birdie or chip-in during your LGA round, fill out a Birdie/Chip-In Form found in the desk in the Ladies Card Room. Completed and attested forms should be placed in the designated box.
- 2. If there are temporary greens the day of league play:
  - a) If a player actually strikes the ball onto a temporary green and it goes in the hole for a chip in, the player will be rewarded for the chip in. Fill in the appropriate form the day of play.
  - b) If a player is on a temporary green and actually putts/strikes the ball for a birdie, the player will be awarded the birdie. Fill in the appropriate form and submit.
  - c) A player will NOT for awarded a birdie if a 2-putt rule is applied for the score on a temporary green.

Some information comes from the Pro Shop via email. Your Thursday play schedule comes from <u>auto-send@foretees.com</u> and will show your tee time and foursome.

If someone in your foursome cancels play, you will get an email from <u>auto-send@foretees.com</u> about the cancellation. If you decide not to play on Thursday, you need to remove your name from Fore-tees and call someone in your foursome to tell them you are going to cancel. This is a courtesy to your group so they do not wait for you on the first tee.

Our best way of communicating through the LGA is <u>lgareporter@gmail.com</u>, so please read all the posts.

#### Luncheons

48-hour notice is required when cancelling from an LGA tournament and luncheon. Please contact Rob Kinard in the Pro Shop and Daniella/Tanya in Food & Beverage to give notice. Do not leave a message in their voicemail.

#### ForeTees

If you want to make tee times online, you can enter ForeTees from the ClubCorp website: <u>www.clubcorp.com/Clubs/Woodside-Plantation-Country-Club</u>. Go to Member Sign-in and click on Golf Tee Times; go to Tee Times and then Make, Change or View Tee Times. Pick a date, course and tee time.

If you want to register for a golf event, sign in to ClubCorp's website, click on Golf Tee Times, then Events. Click on your event and add your name.

#### HANDICAP PROCEDURES

The current procedure to review accuracy of posting scores as outlined in the attachment to the 2021 WLGS Golf Handbook will continue to be enforced.

The LGA Board voted to implement this procedure for the review of posting of scores on Thursday/Saturday play days. This will also pertain to scores from rounds played outside of Woodside, as well as CSRA events. If you play on Thursday/Saturday play days, or in a CSRA event, you are responsible for posting your score. <u>All scores must be</u> <u>posted</u>, no matter where you played, within one week of the play date.

The LGA Handicap Committee will follow the WCC policy and maintain a list of individuals who have not posted three consecutive scores and will notify them by e-mail and warn them of possible penalties. The 4<sup>th</sup> time and all future times, the member has not posted, the Tournament, Ringers and Birdies/Chip-ins Committees will be notified and the player will forfeit any points and any awards earned for the date of play. If this infraction continues, the member will not be eligible to play with the LGA the following month. As part of the score card review process, the LGA Handicap Committee will continue to monitor the scores for Equitable Stroke Control (ESC). Any corrections will be made by the Committee with notification sent to the individual.

Please remember to check your handicap prior to play. The handicaps are posted in the folder next to the computer in the Pro Shop.

## **POSTING SCORES**

Post scores on pro shop computer GHIN website/app. Posting of your score must be done on the date of play.

### RINGERS

You may sign up to participate in the Ringers Tournament on both the Jones and Cupp courses. The cost is \$4.00 for the year. The Ringer game is set up with each hole on each course.

Your first scorecard on each course is used to start the Ringer Tournament. Hole scores will be taken from Thursday or Saturday LGA games. Each scorecard must be signed, dated and attested. Each hole that you play each week is compared with the first scorecard you turned in. As your score improves on each hole, that score is noted on a tally sheet. It is a challenge for each member to try to improve her score over each hole played.

Players that are DQ'd or WD, are not eligible for Ringers on that game day.

Ringers will not count when temporary greens are in use.

At the end of the WLGA year, all the scores are totaled and prizes given for low gross and low net per flight for each course, as well as most improved handicap.

The Ringer sheets for both courses are posted in the ladies' cardroom so participants can see what holes need to be worked on and improve their scoring average.

## 2021 TEE FOR TWO (T42)

Pick a WLGA partner and sign up for this fun seasonal tournament It begins February 1st and ends in November 30<sup>th</sup>

#### What is Tee-For-Two?

- Tee-For-Two (T42) is a better ball net tournament consisting of six rounds of golf (3 played on Cupp and 3 played on Jones) with two WPLGA members making up each team.
- There are three flights in Tee-For-Two for the 2021 season: Burden Tee teams, Azalea Tee teams, and Mixed Tee teams.
- A Burden Tee team consists of two LGA-designated Burden players. An Azalea Tee team consists of two LGA-designated Azalea Tee players. A Mixed team consists of one designated Burden player and one designated Azalea player. All players must use their LGA-designated tee when playing T42.
- Winners will be determined based on the cumulative total of the six rounds played. Equal cash prizes will be awarded to the best one-third in each flight, including ties. All winners will receive the same amount of prize money, regardless of flight.

#### What do I need to do to participate in Tee-For-Two?

- Pick a WLGA partner and sign up at the Kickoff or in the Ladies Locker Room.
- Cost is \$10.00 per player (by check payable to WLGA) to be submitted to the Tee-For-Two Committee chair(s). No refunds are given if the team is unable to complete the tournament.

#### **HOLE-IN-ONE**

You may join/subscribe to the WLGA Hole-In-One Club by being a member of the 18hole and/or the 9-hole Ladies' Golf Associations of Woodside Plantation. This is done through the LGA Treasuerer, who forwards this information to the Club's accountant.

To be eligible to win the pot, the hole-in-one must be scored during any regular round of golf played at Woodside. This includes an 18-hole or 9-hole round. It may be played any day of the week.

To be eligible to win the pot, the hole-in-one must be scored during a round of golf that can be turned in for handicap purposes. Note: An eligible round of golf does not include alternate shot games or captain's choice games.

The round of golf should be attested by a fellow player.

Each time a Woodside female golf member, who has joined the Hole-In-One Club, gets a hole-in-one, \$1.00 will be charged to participating members' Woodside account.

If you are a member of the Hole-In-One Club and get a hole-in-one, your Woodside account will be credited \$1.00 for each participating Woodside Hole-In-One Club female member.

### THE TWO CLUB

The "2 – Club " is a group of ladies that have come together to reward each other when a lady golfer gets a 2 on any hole. While the clube is not technically part of the WLGA, many WLGA women participate. To start, there is an initiation of \$1.00 to join when a member gets a two. Subsequently, any player who scores a two, when playing with another "2-Club" member is paid \$1.00 for that accomplishment.

## CSRA ROUND ROBIN TOURNAMENTS

The Central Savannah River Area Women's Golf Association (CSRA WGA) is made up of ten (10) Golf Clubs in Georgia and South Carolina: Cedar Creek, Gordon Lakes, Houndslake, Midland Valley, Mount Vintage, The Reserve Club, Savannah Lakes, West Lake, Bartram Trail and Woodside.

The tournaments are held at a different member clubs in every month but December and January and are open to any 18-hole golfer who is a CSRA member. To participate in a CSRA event, you must have twenty (20) posted scores from Woodside Plantation. (If a woman belongs to two clubs, she must declare one club as her home club. She should let the CSRA representative know her club of declaration.) All CSRA information is available on the CSRA website: <u>www.csrawga.com</u>.

All tournament fees must be paid through the CSRA club representative only and submitted to the host club by the deadline. The Woodside CSRA club representative will post a sheet in the Ladies Locker Room announcing the club to be played each month, the cost and number of members who can participate. (If there are more ladies who want to participate than spots available, those who have participated in the most tournaments will get first priority). Once the entry sheet has been submitted, no further entries are accepted.

Round Robin tournaments check-in is 8:30 a.m. at the host club, with a shotgun start at 9 a.m. (unless otherwise posted). A luncheon and short awards presentation follows play. Prizes are awarded on a gross and net basis, with a <u>low gross and low net of the field</u> and a <u>low gross and low net in each flight</u>. In most cases, prizes are in the form of gift certificates redeemable at the host club's Pro Shop. Each woman participating in a Round Robin, receives points toward the Memorial Cup awards, for attendance and for first through third in her flight.

*Cancellation Policy:* A full refund will be given only if the cancellation is made 7 days before the tournament start date. Refund of the <u>cart fee only</u> may be made if the host club representative is notified of the withdrawal by 6 p.m. of the day prior to the day of the tournament. No fees will be refunded after the tournament begins. This policy applies to all CSRA WGA tournaments.

All tournaments are flighted according to USGA Index. All players play to a 40-handicap maximum.
